

## **Explorit Science Center Summer Camp 2022 COVID Procedures**

### **Masking Policy:**

Masks will be required for all staff, volunteers and campers.  
Snack breaks will take place outside during which masks can be removed for eating and drinking.

### **Location of Camp Activities:**

Camp activities will be taking place both inside\* our classroom and outside on the science center grounds and in the surrounding Mace Ranch Park.

\*Air purifiers will be in use.

### **Before Camp:**

All surfaces, restrooms, supplies, etc. that campers will be coming in contact with will be disinfected prior to their arrival.

All staff and volunteers will have a daily Health Screening, including a temperature check.

-Any staff member or volunteer with a fever >100.4 will not be allowed to work, and must exit facility.

### **Camper Drop Off:**

Campers will be signed-in by an adult at a designated outdoor check-in station.

Daily Health Screening will be done for each camper, including a temperature check.

-If a camper presents with a fever >100.4 they will not be allowed to stay for camp.

Each camper will be asked to use the Hand Sanitizer Station as they enter the classroom to begin the day.

### **During Camp:**

Masking will be enforced throughout camp.

Hand washing and use of hand sanitizer will be encouraged.

### **Camper Pick Up:**

Adults will sign out their camper from the designated outdoor station.

A staff member or volunteer will bring their camper to them once sign out is complete.

### **After Camp:**

Daily housekeeping methods will be applied. Disinfection of tables, chairs, surfaces, equipment, supplies, restrooms, sinks, door handles, light switches, etc. will be performed.

### **What Campers Should Bring To Camp:**

Water bottle clearly labeled with their name.

Snack to eat at break time.

Sunscreen should be applied before drop off. Hats are ok to be worn during outside activities. Closed-toe shoes only. No sandals, crocs or keens-these shoes tend to have openings that small stones, sticks and stickers can get into during outside walks. No toys or electronics please.
